

GRADES OF GREEN YOUTH BOARD OF ADVISORS FINAL PRESENTATION

At the conclusion of the 2012-2013 school year, all Youth Board Advisors will give a presentation to the Youth Board and Grades of Green staff and Board Members at the last Youth Board of Advisors meeting.

Presentation Guidelines

1. Each board member will have up to 5 minutes to give their presentation.
2. Your presentation should include:
 - A description of the Green Project Plan you chose to implement at your school. What project/s was it? Why did you choose this project/s?
 - A summary of how you rolled out the project, including how you advertised it, who helped you make it happen, what materials/resources you used, etc.
 - A discussion of the successes and hardships of your project. What did you learn from it? What went well? What did not go well and how did you resolve it?
 - Advice for anyone who wants to try this project at their school.
 - Advice for Grades of Green on how to include your project in the Grades of Green program or how to improve an existing Grades of Green activity.
3. Prepare some sort of visual display. You can create a display board, poster, or collage for example. You can also bring in props if they relate to your project. Pictures are a great addition!

Please note: Presentations do not need to be memorized, and Youth Board Advisors will not be evaluated on their presentation in any way. We simply want to celebrate the success of your project with you and hear how it went and how we can improve the overall Grades of Green program in the future.
